GFWC X-JWC is a member of the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC) with clubs in every state and 9 foreign countries. Our headquarters is located in the prestigious DuPont Circle area of Washington, DC. Additionally, we are a member of GFWC-Wyoming, comprised of 9 clubs throughout the state. Club members are dedicated to community improvement through volunteer service. GFWC was founded in 1890, GFWC-Wyoming in 1904 and X-JWC was formed in 1940.

WELCOME

Club members are always looking for women to join them who are interested in volunteering to make a difference in our community, state and nation. In addition to working on projects, members enjoy social activities, make lifelong friends and learn about needs and opportunities for service available locally. Guidance and information from GFWC and GFWC Wyoming help members make good use of their time and resources to benefit our community.

MEETINGS

The club meets the first Tuesday of each month, September through May, for a luncheon meeting. Lunch is served at 11:30 with meeting following, usually adjourning by 2:00 p.m. Members are contacted each month by Friday the previous week to determine attendance. If unable to attend, lunch reservations must be cancelled by Sunday prior to the meeting. Business casual is appropriate dress for meetings. Members enjoy an interesting speaker or program at monthly club luncheon meetings.

Board meetings are held the last Tuesday of each month and are open to all members. Contact club president for time and location.

Annual dues are \$38 payable by May 31. A new member joining in January or February will pay \$19 for the remainder of the club year.
